This Indenture made the eleventh day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and five, between Daniel Genung and Lucretia his wife, of the Township of Hanover, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, of the one part, and Luke Miller of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey of the other part Witnesseth that the said Daniel Genung and Lucretia his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred eighty seven and a half Dollars, good and lawful money of the United States to them in hand well and truly paid by the said Luke Miller, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Daniel Genung and Lucretia his wife therewith fully satisfied, contented and paid, have given Grant Bargain and Sold alien Enfeoff Conveyance and Confirmation, and by these presents do Give Grant Bargain Sell alien Enfeoff Convey and Confirm, to the said Luke Miller, and to his heirs and assigns for ever, that moiety or half part of that Tract or parcel of Land and Premises herein after particularly described, situate lying and being in the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, bounded and bounded as follows; beginning at a white oak Tree standing on the West side of the Road leading from the dwelling house of Calvin Genung to the house Daniel Burnett, and from thence running first South Sixty Degrees West eighteen Chains and fifty three links to the line of said Daniel Burnett's Land, thence 2) in the line of the same North forty four Degrees and thirty minutes West, four chains and thirty four links to a corner of said Luke Miller's Land, thence 3) in his line North thirty eight Degrees East six Chains and twenty five links, to a corner of Calvin Genung's Land, thence 4) in the line of said Calvin Genung's Land, North twenty one Degrees East six Chains and thirteen links to his here,
