to them in hand paid by the said Luke Miller before writing
and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said trustees do hereby
acknowledge do acquit & discharge the said Luke Miller thereof
forever have given granted bargain'd sold alien'd alloted & released
convey'd & confirm'd & by these presents do give grant bargain sell
alien allote release convey and confirm unto him the said
Luke Miller & his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or lot of
land situated in the township of Chatham adjoining on the West
leading from the Bottle Hill Road to the house of Aaron Burnett
being part of Land belonging to said Church & Congregation

called The Parsonage in the hands of said trustees Beginning in said Road (1) North forty seven degrees west twenty one chain along the line of Aaron Burnett thence (2) to the line of Godwin Bassmont Smith two degrees east fourteen chain & seventy two links to a corner of lands late Eliza Cookes thence (3) in his line North eighty eight degrees east fourteen chain & twenty four links to the place of beginning containing ten acres & eightly four hundredths of an acre of land be the same more or less with all the right title interest property claim & demand of the said trustees of in and to the same. To have and to hold the said lot of land and premises with all the profits privileges hereditaments & appurtenances unto the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Luke Miller & his heirs & assigns forever & to the only proper use benefit & behoof of him the said Luke Miller & to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Thompson Samuel Murchmore Samuel Demman William Britton Stephen Day Jun^r and Flavel Woodruff for themselves their heirs & assigns & each & every of them Executors & Administrators jointly & severally do hereby covenant with the said Luke Miller his heirs & assigns that they the trustees as such have been duly appointed & agreed to have been sworn & thereby legally authorized & empowered to grant bargain sell & convey the above granted lands & premises & that they or either of them in their official capacity as trustees aforesaid or otherwise have not done suffered or caused to be done any act matter or thing that has can or may in any way whatsoever disannul defeat or destroy the title of the said Luke Miller his heirs or assigns of in and to the above granted lands or any part thereof that he the said Luke Miller his heirs and assigns shall forever hereafter have hold use occupy possess and enjoy the same free & clear of all incumbrances in the law whatsoever.
