Marriage & Family BREAKING THE NEWS

Perhaps the most difficult part of deciding to get a divorce is how to tell the children. It's awkward for the parents and even harder for the children. But one thing is clear. Necessary discussions between the parents should be completed well before the children are told, so that the decision can be presented to them without anger or uncertainty.

be mommy and daddy to the children. Emphasize that when parents separate and divorce, the children are not being divorced from either parent. A parent's flight from home before children are informed of the parental decision to divorce is ill-advised because that would leave children no time to go through the natural stages of separation.

The best setting is to have a talk with both parents and all the children present. Make clear that the divorce is from the marriage only and that mommy and daddy will continue to

The parents, not the children, should decide where the children will live, how often they will see the other parent and other issues. Working with a marriage counselor can be very helpful in guiding the family through this stressful transition period.

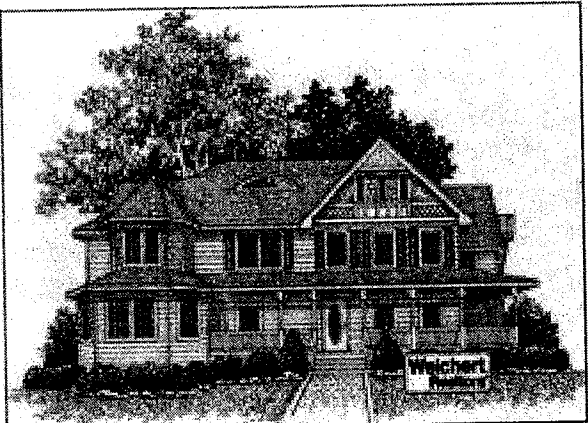
